### OTP Update—Regional Transition Plans

All GymSports Officers have been working with regions to develop each new region's Regional Transition Plan.

Each plan details the legal requirements for winding up the region as well as plans for continuation of regional activities, regional events, and administration for regional teams for Nationals.

The plan is a document jointly owned by current regional associations, new regional boards and the GymSports Officer.

This document aims to insure a smooth transition process and help all regions wind up by June 30, 2008.
